Due to the Coronavirus this year's rules and regulations are different to normal and all entries will be FREE OF CHARGE.

Appledore Visitor Association's photographic competition 'What I love about Appledore' is open to everyone, old or young, visitor or local, **EXCEPT PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHERS**. There will be no limit to the number of entries by any individual and there is no age limit for entrants. Photos can be old or new, taken any time. The winning entries will be published in the AVA 2021 calendar entitled: 'What I love about Appledore'. Each winner will receive a certificate of congratulations and a copy of the calendar containing the winner's photo.

Type of photo:

Entries can be in either portrait or landscape format. The photograph must be **in jpg form**, sent by **email and be at least 300dpi**. **Any photographs containing pictures of children must have parental permission for publication.**

THE SUBJECT LINE OF YOUR EMAIL SHOULD HAVE THE FILE NAME and TITLE OF YOUR PHOTO: e.g. *App 001 Appledore in the Sunset*.

THE CONTENTS OF THE MESSAGE must contain the entrant's name, address, phone number and the file name and title of their photograph. *For example: Fred Bloggs, 198 The Quay, Appledore, EX39 1QS. Tel: 01237 444444. Entry: APP001 Appledore in the Sunset.* The photos must be attached to this email message with the matching file name e.g.: *APP001 Appledore in the Sunset*
EVERY PHOTO SENT IN MUST HAVE A DIFFERENT FILE NAME

Closing date for entries: All entries must be received by the end of Sunday 6th September 2020. Winners will be announced at the end of October. Calendars will be available as soon after that date as possible and prizes will be awarded at 'AVA - Appledore Christmas Festivities' on Friday 4th December or posted immediately following that date.

AVA retains the right to use all photos entered in the calendar and any other publicity the AVA may wish to use it for, such as on the website, marketing material etc. but all published photos will bear the name of the photographer. Email addresses will remain confidential and not used for any other purpose.
